The year started off with our chapter meeting on September 17th with Heath Suddleson who spoke on the topic of "Managing Client Expectations Without Losing Your Shirt or the Next















Job". On October 15th, Jennifer Austin talked about "Successfully Managing Large Organizational Change Endeavors". On Wednesday, November 19, 2014 Jeff Nuding spoke on "Accelerated Leadership: Agile and OODA". This presentation explained the basic principles of the Observe, Orient, Decide, Act (OODA) concept, drew parallels with Agile development techniques, and suggested implications for portfolio and project management. Jeff is a member of our chapter who has presented at PMI North America Congresses in 2003, 2007, 2008, 2009, and 2012. On Wednesday, January 21, 2015, John W. Waechter, PMP, CPG spoke on the topic: From Pipefitter to PhD – Do you know who you are talking to? Communications on large environmental construction projects. On Wednesday, February 18, 2015, Paul Franz, CBAP spoke on "Requirements Management; How to exceed stakeholder expectations, improve performance, meet expected project benefits and achieve tangible business outcomes." This meeting was co-hosted with the International Institute of Business Analysis (IIBA) Albany Capital District Chapter. On Wednesday, March 18, 2015, Nancy Mulholland, Chief Portfolio Officer, NYS Office of Information Technology Services spoke on "The Role of the Chief Portfolio Officer in New York State." This meeting was co-hosted with the NYS Forum. On Wednesday, April 15, 2015 Mary Beth Imbarrato, PMP, CSM, LIMC will speak on "Lessons Learned - Leveraging Your Team's Feedback." Mary Beth is currently the Program Director for PMIEF at our chapter and has spoken at PMI Regional Meetings.

2015 Flections for UNY-PMI BOD

Overview

The positions on the UNY-PMI Board of Directors are open effective June 1, 2015 as the two year terms of the incumbents are expiring (with the exception of the President). The terms for these openings are June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2017. This is an excellent opportunity for current members to become more active in the governance of the PMI-UNY chapter.

Eligibility, Responsibilities, & PDUs

To run for a Board position, candidates must be a UNY-PMI member in good standing and a regular attendee of the monthly meetings. Member in good standing means you have paid your membership dues. Regular attendee means you have attended at least four (4) meetings in the last PMI year. For details, refer to the UNY-PMI bylaws. Board members are expected to attend monthly chapter meetings and monthly Board meetings. Board members receive ten PDUs for serving on the Board.

Election Activities

- Communications candidates may communicate, one-on-one, regarding their candidacy only if the communication focuses on their qualifications. *Mass communications are prohibited including social media*. The candidates may not make reference to any other candidate or any existing or past Directors
- Campaign materials No candidate or PMI member may utilize any campaign materials such as posters, buttons/lapel pins, group activities or sponsorships.
- Candidate communications with the Institute the candidate should discuss the position with former directors or a member of the nominating committee.

Board Positions

Board candidates do not run for a specific position. Candidates run "at large." Newly-elected (and re-elected) Board members are appointed to specific positions on the Board by a vote of the current members of the PMI-UNY Board of Directors.

Voting

Any current member can vote. Members can cast votes in one of three ways:

- 1. At the April 15th PMI-UNY Chapter meeting;
- 2. Via electronic method such as e-mail or Survey Monkey no later Wednesday, April 8, 2015;
- 3. Via USPS to PMI Upstate New York Chapter, P.O. Box 11132, Loudonville, NY 12211. **Ballots must be received by April 8, 2015.**
